MAGICAL BRAVADO was patiently ridden tracking a contested pace, swung four wide entering the stretch, drew even mid stretch vying for the lead in a three way battle, drew off late under aggressive handling. T. G. HERO rushed into the far turn, duelled from the quarter pole, brushed lightly with ZIP IN TIME upper stretch, was under strong left handed stick, battled to deep stretch but was no match for the winner nearing the wire. ZIP IN TIME rushed from the gate, set a pressured pace throughout, brushed with T.G.HERO in upper stretch vying for the lead, was outfinished late just failing to hold on to second place. JAY ARTHUR brushed with FIRE ROAD at the start, hustled up along the rail to stalk, almost drew even mid stretch, was outgamed nearing the finish line needing a bit more late. KING THOU ART raced up close from the start, was in tight and steadied briefly at the eighth pole running between foes, once clear in deep stretch lacked kick. FIRE ROAD brushed at the break, saved ground running towards the rear, lacked response, never threatened. FAST EL TIGRE raced evenly while four wide on the bend, failed to factor. ALL THE GLORY was quickly outrun, showed little.
