Footnotes

FLATTER ME FIRST patiently ridden in the early going, asked mid turn, gained coming five wide into the stretch, raced abreast a pair of rivals in mid stretch, drew off late under energetic handling. FAKE PERSONALITY tracked the pace racing off the rail, bid four wide at the quarter pole, took a slight lead in mid stretch, was no match for the winner in deep stretch and settled for second best in a good effort. HOPE RESTORED prompted the pace racing along the rail, vied in a three way battle mid turn, put a head in front at the quarter pole, came off the rail turning for home, fought gamely to mid stretch, weakened in deep stretch holding the show position. BIRDMUDIFUL well placed early on tracking a contested pace, put to a drive leaving the far turn, failed to respond and tired in the lane besting rest. NEED TO KNOW pressed for the lead to the half racing three wide, began to fade top of the lane, used up. NEW GIRL hustled from the gate, set a pressured pace for the run down the backstretch being headed from both sides, dueled to the quarter pole then started to weaken, no factor in the lane. MARSHAS BABY was soon outrun, gave way middle of the second turn, stopped and finished being across the finish line.
