AIDAN'S SUGAR set a well rated pace traveling in the two path, turned away LIMEHOUSE LEZA leaving the quarter pole, then kept MY MISS MARY at bay throughout the stretch run under steady handling to the wire. MY MISS MARY rated early racing mid track, roused from the quarter pole, took aim on AIDAN'S SUGAR near the quarter pole, was kept safe in the lane while finishing a willing second best. SHE WAS FREE unhurried running mid track down the backside, rallied coming five wide into the lane, surged late winning the battle for third place but never threatened top pair. LIMEHOUSE LEZA stalked then pressed the winner racing three wide to the half, began to drop off in upper stretch and was edged out of third place nearing the finish line. SOLICITUDE settled mid pack traveling off the rail, put to a drive from mid turn, lacked needed surge never menacing. FASIG GIRL was forwardly placed in the early going, roused to no avail from mid turn, no factor in the drive. DOCTOR ZEN lacked speed and trailed around the second turn, showed little. HARLAN LIGHT pressed the winner to the half racing along the rail, began to fade entering the stretch, used up.
