SEVENTEEN AND ONE stalked the pace circling out on the far turn advancing to clear in the three path upper stretch, angled to the inside holding under a drive near the rail. SLI NA GARPPLE slow early gained four wide into upper stretch, gave steady surge in the four path angling in late pressing the winner at the wire. RON BURGUNDY gave a prompted middle move pressing to grab the lead on the far turn, overpowered in upper stretch angled to the three path while weakening late. QUITE SPECTACULAR sent hard pressured the pace through the backside then weakened dropping off on the far turn. ARISTOCRAT AGAIN dropped back early trailing for three quarters, swung six wide in upper stretch gave an even finish. WARRIOR'S HIT reluctant loading was hurried from the gate pressing on the backside, wavered on the far turn fading into upper stretch. ATLANTIC DANCER was never involved. LONSDALE offered little. BLACKEYE WYNN pressed on lead through the backside then gave way on the far turn.
