GO NOW broke alertly, was taken back and moved out to mid track to stalk going down the backside, sat patient to mid turn, bid between foes from the quarter pole, came into the lane in a four way duel, put a head in front mid stretch, inched clear late, prevailed under a stiff drive. YACHT BROKER rated early, asked far turn, rallied five wide top of the stretch, drew even in a four way duel at the furlong marker, was out gamed late, got the place position in a good try. MALIBU MOONSHINE stalked the pace racing four wide, gained mid turn, vied between rivals in a four way battle, matched strides throughout the drive, was in close quarters coming to the wire, out gamed late, hard effort. O'CONNELL'S (BRZ) rated from the start, raced in hand to the quarter pole, was just off the pace turning for home, had no room in upper stretch, bumped twice with GUARDIANOFTHENORTH at the eighth pole, surged late racing in tight quarters at the finish. GUARDIANOFTHENORTH was allowed to go off and set the pace, traveled off the rail, set a very soft opening half time, dueled from the quarter pole when the tempo picked up, dug in to mid stretch, bumped with O'CONNELL'S at the furlong marker, tired late.
