RAINY DAY WILLIE raced in good stalking position, rallied three wide mid turn, collared YOUTHFUL SPIRIT in upper stretch, drove clear at the sixteenth pole, won going away under a drive. YOUTHFUL SPIRIT was hustled from the gate, pressured by KARIENS going to the half, put that rival away mid turn, was headed by RAINY DAY WILLIE in upper stretch, dug in running along the inside, wore down late holding on to second place in a game effort. PADDY TAP well placed early on, sat patient to the quarter pole, set down turning for home, lacked needed surge besting rest. AMIGO MIO unhurried leaving the gate, traveled towards the inside around the turn, improved placing but never menaced. SET TO ROLL was a step slow from the gate, advanced going to the half, chased form the quarter pole receiving strong left handed stick, leveled off in the drive. SHOOK DOWN settled in the second flight, roused mid turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch, failed to respond, no threat. SOCIAL WORKER raced five wide down the backstretch, lacked response when asked, raced a bit wider in upper stretch, showed little. KARLENS sent early, raced five wide into the first turn, pressed the runner up to the half, started to fade at the quarter pole, finished spent. PASS THE CASH was always outrun, dull effort. M. N. M. EXPRESS hustled giving a brief chase, stopped midway on the second turn, finished well beaten.
