SHERRIBALDI broke sharply clearing the field, hustled on lead opened to a commanding margin out of the turn being kept to task along the inside. LESLIE'S OCEAN raced evenly saving ground to upper stretch, responded in the two path getting up for place. OUTPUT slow early came five wide to upper stretch finishing evenly at mid track. PASS ME A DRINK chased the pace through the turn extending in the three path upper stretch, would wear down late. ROYAL TERMS away slowly was swung out eight wide in upper stretch improving modestly. NATURALLY BOLD slow early was angled six wide in upper stretch finding no late surge. DREWLEE chased early then wavered on the turn dropping from contention. I'M INUIT was always outrun. LUCKY LASSIE struggled throughout finishing near the rail.
