CLIFF DIVIN unhurried early advanced on the far turn, bid abreast rivals in the four path upper stretch drawing out late. ZEPHYR LIGHT tracked the pace moving evenly through the far turn, angled from the two to the three path in mid stretch rallying up for place. KELLHAM sent clear set a modest pace through the backside, hooked on the far turn was carried in toward the rail upper stretch wearing down late. DUTCH REWARD stalked the pace pressing up to even terms on the far turn, dueling abreast KELLHAM in upper stretch was joined by others on the outside wearing to pressure late. STREET SHOES LARRY raced evenly throughout holding position in the four path through the stretch. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB slow early would fail to respond. POWERHOUSE folded up after a half mile. HISTORIAN was always outrun.
