SHE HAS A HEART hustled clear worked on pace through the turn, took charge in upper stretch drawing out in the three path. POTLUCK PRIZE a step slow through the turn came four wide upper stretch, found best stride late surging near the wire to grab place. WALTZING TIME sent hard chased through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch proved no match for the winner while hanging late. FLATTER ME ROSE slow early saved ground to upper stretch finishing evenly in the two path. INDIAN FOOTSTEPS hustled out pursued along the inside through the turn, extending near the rail down the lane would come up short. NAJARANS STAR slow early was swung out seven wide in upper stretch. PRINCESS ADITI pinched at the break played no factor. PEAKABOO I C U was always outrun.
