Footnotes

FAST FASHION sent hard would pressure the pace through the turn, extended along the inside in drive edged up gamely. FOXTROT FRANKIE stalked early moving to leaders on the turn, locked up abreast FAST FASHION there being out gamed late. JAY'S SUAVE raced evenly through the turn, roused at mid track continued with steady response while needing more. WILD GOOSE CREEK slow early was swung out eight wide in upper stretch picking up others. SPRING FARM pressed from the outside battling FAST FASHION through the turn, came five wide to lane wearing down under the whip. TOUCH OF QUALITY stumbling at the break played no factor. ANGLE OF ATTACK pressed early then gave way. WINDHAM HILL was never involved. HARKING flashed early speed from the rail then folded up at the quarter pole.
