BRAVE REWARD raced up close from the start, bid three wide running between foes at the quarter pole, vied in a four way battle in upper stretch, edged clear late under strong handling. RULER BOY settled in mid pack while not far off a contested pace, angled out six wide mid stretch, closed strongly in deep stretch gaining second place. RUMMY'S COMMAND stalked early on racing along the rail, loomed off the winner mid stretch, needed a bit more late and was out nodded missing second place in a hard effort. VICTORIOUS JET settled in the second flight, rallied six wide top of the lane, loomed from the eighth pole but was outfinished late vying for a minor placing. GEODI'S GOLD unhurried leaving the gate, mounted bid running between foes at the quarter pole, angled towards the inside in upper stretch, failed to threaten late needing more. ASSURANCE raced up close from the start, almost drew even at the quarter pole, began to give way inside the furlong marker, used up. ENZO THE BAKER broke alertly and made the lead going down the backstretch, headed past the quarter pole, battled to upper stretch, gave way finishing spent. AZSTOR was hustled from the gate but lacked early foot, settled in the second flight, failed to respond when asked for more. VINCENT CAN GO was always outrun, showed little. WORD OF ADVICE raced wide while dropping off on the bend, offered little.
