AWAITING GOOD NEWS nicely rated, saved ground, asked far turn, rallied 4 wide top of the stretch, bid and cleared in upper stretch, won going away. ROMANCING dueled, between horses to 3/16, rail duel in lane, was no match late but proved to be second best. WHAT'S SO FUNNY outrun for a 1/2, angled into lane, hard ridden throughout the stretch run, finished gamely. BAT LADY rated from gate, saved ground, roused, angled in stretch, gained late. STORMY WHITNEY raced 4 wide into first turn, rushed bid backside, between 3/16, continued to be urged on but tired in the drive. BOLDLY CERTAIN pushed hard from gate, rail duel early, faded on turn, finished even late. EXCUSE unhurried early from gate, asked on far turn, brief bid, leveled off in the drive. RUNAWAY ROAD pressed pace while between horses, chased on the turn, tired at 1/4 pole. CLEVER SIS raced 5 wide, into first turn, vied backside, eased top of lane.
