**Footnotes**

BALM BAY was bumped shortly after the start, moved out wide far turn, rushed bid to take over leaving the quarter pole, drove clear and angled towards the rail, was kept to steady pressure to the wire, held firm. MADLY PADDLIN HOME broke alertly, was quickly headed running five wide early, headed by the winner leaving the quarter pole, moved over to the rail top of the lane, chased winner throughout the stretch run, gamely saved the place position. IRISHAMERICANDREAM rushed early, vied while between rivals throughout, was in hard pursuit from upper stretch, finished willingly. KYLE'S TREASURY settled in the second flight, angled out top of the stretch, gave late surge rallying between foes late. MAJOR STRIKE sent hard, pressed briefly, chased from mid turn, hard try. QUESTIONABLE SKY stalked early, rallied four wide to a menacing position at the quarter pole, tired late under a drive. ECHOING RIDGE showed good speed, vied briefly running between rivals, was hard ridden into the stretch, no late threat. ONELASTGIFT broke a bit out and bumped with BALM BAY shortly after the start, trailed to top of the stretch, did have a belated stride but was no threat. TALIA'S CHOICE settled in the second flight, angled to mount brief bid entering the lane, flattened out. STATELY CLOCK was hustled from the gate, raced up close early, was caught in tight and had to steady briefly on the turn, dropped off and was no factor.
