**Footnotes**

ISNT HE well rated racing towards the inside for the run down the backstretch, angled four wide while gaining on the duelers coming to the quarter pole, drove clear and was kept to pressure holding safe to the finish. MILWAUKEE HIGH settled in mid pack, asked mid turn, came four wide into the lane, finished willingly to gain the place position in a hard effort. ALYTORO pressed for the lead, vied in three way battle to the half, edged clear around the turn, was no match from upper stretch, weakened late besting rest. THE RARE COMMANDER hustled from the gate, vied for the lead running along the rail, began to fade entering the stretch, used up. ALL PLAY tracked a contest pace, put to a stiff drive at the quarter pole, failed to respond lacking kick. ONE LAST GRAF lacked speed, saved ground throughout, did mildly improve placing but was no threat. IM FOR LEXI raced evenly traveling five wide down the backside, hard ridden giving no response from the three eighths pole, no threat. ROVE was unhurried and trailed in the early stages, angled six wide top of the lane, never factored. WISE MOUNTAIN was sent setting a pressured pace to the half, began to give way leaving the quarter pole, finished weary. LIVELY EXIT dropped off going down the backside, raced wide, was eased in the stretch.
