Footnotes

BLUES CROSSING raced evenly while losing ground through the turn, emerged at mid track locking up late inside of EVANSVILLE GLITTER, got up in close quarters. EVANSVILLE GLITTER away slowly was circled out into the turn coming six wide to upper stretch, surged abreast BLUES CROSSING in the closing yards missing in close. WANNA BEA LIKE LAC stalked early firing out of the turn to draw even three deep in upper stretch, continued to respond late while ceding to wide pressure. SNUCK IN THE DANCE chased early rallying to even terms from between horses in upper stretch, battled late coming up a bit short. HERE'S BEAUREGARD hustled out would work to clear on the turn, collared along the inside in upper stretch wore to pressure. TOSS saved ground in pursuit dropping off on the turn, had no recovery. LUHUK WHO'S COMING sent hard pressed then chased HERE'S BEAUREGARD through the turn, gave way when empty in upper stretch. HOT WIRE was always outrun.
