LAZYLOU CARSON slow early rallied while angling out to upper stretch, surged up late driving. BOLDER COURSE sent hard was pressed on a short lead, widened in upper stretch, was run down late. SHORE TEE was hustled close up, chased into upper stretch then finished evenly. TWENTYNINE KNOCKS off slowly labored through the turn, gave a mild rally down the stretch. SERVICE ACT went evenly, gained on the turn then wavered the final eighth. STOLEN GREETING off slowly played no factor. PLANTED PINES dropped off on the turn. LARK'S TUNE was jammed and steadied break. WINDSOR CAT was hustled out, pressed early then gave way on the turn. CELTIC CHIEF veered in at the break, labored after.
