AWESOME AFFAIR set a pressured pace throughout, repulsed BAMBOO GAP entering the stretch, then had to dig in turning away KING OF LORDS in last jumps, holding on in a very determined effort. KING OF LORDS settled nicely running towards the inside going down the backstretch, angled out near the quarter pole, bid four wide upper stretch, surged late just missing in a game effort. SNOWBOARD RIDGE raced up close stalking a hotly contested duel, bid to a menacing position mid stretch, lacked late punch in deep stretch, bested rest. LOCOMOTION unhurried early lagging far off the pace, rallied along the rail from top of the lane, finished with interest but was no real threat. TRES COPAS settled in the second flight, varied little never threatening. BAMBOO GAP pressed AWESOME AFFAIR soon after the start, loomed off that rival to top of the stretch, was all done and began to fade in mid stretch. KWAME showed little racing mid track, no factor. INHERITANCE LOST raced in mid pack to the quarter pole, gave way entering the stretch racing four to five wide.
