GAMBLING DON stalked the pace looming close up through the far turn, engaged IMPERIAL CROWN wresting the lead in upper stretch then held off a surging FAST GRIEVANCE with full extension late. FAST GRIEVANCE unhurriedly began to respond on the far turn, angled out into upper stretch took aim at mid track surging late pressing GAMBLING DON at the wire. RULER BOY moved evenly off the pace through the far turn, gave a mild rally in the three path upper stretch responding to best the others. IMPERIAL CROWN sent clear set the pace through the far turn, overpowered in upper stretch would fade along the inside. BIG BIG STAR slow early played no factor. KIPLING BOY stalked the pace through the backside then gave way abruptly on the far turn. EL BUFADORA flattened out after a half mile. MAJESTIC VICTORY hopped at the break, trailed through the backside, gave a modest move on the far turn then flattened out in upper stretch.
