DESPINAS DESIRE was never far off the pace saving ground, drew even inside the furlong marker, slowly inched clear at the wire gaining a hard earned victory. WALTZING TIME broke well pressing for the lead from the start, came three wide entering the stretch, vied in a three way battle from mid stretch, was out nodded just missing in a very game effort. MURKY broke alert, was soon pressured by WALTZING TIME, headed from both sides upper stretch, was in tight briefly steadying mid stretch, tired late holding third place in a hard effort. ECONOMIC RISK rushed a four wide move at the quarter pole, loomed off of top three in mid stretch, leveled off needing more late. EASYBABY settled in mid pack running along the rail, roused to no avail lacking serious surge. SARAH DOUGLAS lacked early speed, raced wide throughout, mildly improved placing but never factored. MISTY EYED settled in the second flight, raced between rivals on the bend, lacked response racing four wide from upper stretch. UNDER THE RIM hustled pressing for the early lead, dropped off midway on the turn, stopped top of the stretch and was eased across the finish line.
