ELUSIVE SCHEMES broke alertly setting the pace on a short lead through the turn, moved out in the four path upper stretch angling inside while being ridden out in the two path. GOOD QUESTION stalked the pace edging closer to threaten on the turn, dispatched by the winner in upper stretch was kept to task saving place in the three path. FULL HORSE POWER dropped back early, saving ground to upper stretch responded late finishing well near the rail. TEXAS HOLLADAY chased the pace drawing closer on the turn, came four wide in upper stretch giving an even finish. YUKON PETE reared up high at the break, angled inside gave a mild move in the three path in upper stretch then weakened late between horses. MIDNIGHT THUNDER hustled along gained a bit on the turn then raced evenly from mid track through the lane. LODS faded on the turn. PATRICK N DYLAN hustled along in mid pack would tire in upper stretch. MISSISSIPPI HIPPIE pressured the pace through the turn then gave way in upper stretch. KYLE'S TREASURY was always outrun.
