Footnotes

BULLSTAR prompted the pace racing inside of THUNDER HIGHWAY through the far turn, shook off rival to go clear in upper stretch holding sway under a drive in the two path. GREAT SHOT away slowly stayed back to the half, began to respond leaving the far turn gaining inside then angling four wide late finishing strong. THUNDER HIGHWAY broke alertly pressuring the pace through the far turn, ceded to BULLSTAR in upper stretch drifting out six wide finishing weary. JOE KNOWS ALL tracked the pace while saving ground, dropped off the leaders in upper stretch finishing evenly along the rail. KIZZY'S CHAOS went evenly through the backside, gained ground on the far turn then wavered in the four path upper stretch. CLAYVILLE slow early played no factor. LAIRD'S QUEST was never involved. LAREDO played no factor. BRITELUCK folded up after a half mile. SUNSATIONAL hustled along wilted on the far turn.
