Footnotes

KEY TO LUCK stumbled at the start but quickly recovered, rushed up to duel for the lead racing in the three path abreast a pair of rivals, edged clear at the quarter pole, turned away a threatening BRIDAL TRAIN mid stretch and increased advantage late under steady handling. BRIDAL TRAIN clipped heels off of LIPGLOSSANDGLITTER shortly after the start and stumbled taking up briefly, settled in the second flight, rallied two to three wide entering the stretch, almost drew even with KEY TO LUCK in mid stretch but was turned away to settle for second best in a good effort. DARK ENCHANTRESS hustled early dueling between foes down the backside, had the rail leaving the quarter pole, angled out mid stretch trying to come again, lacked needed kick to settle for third place in a good effort. SARAYU trailed early racing three to four wide, put to a drive top of the stretch, failed to menace besting rest. ZIPPY JAN tracked the pace to mid turn, failed to respond when roused, never threatened. LIPGLOSSANDGLITTER veered in early dueling for the lead, stopped near the quarter pole, spent.
