**Footnotes**

BLACK DRESS unhurried to the far turn, rallied along the rail on the bend, angled out four wide entering the stretch, drew even mid stretch, drove clear late under strong handling. CHIEF MENA rated early on, bid mid turn, came five wide into the lane, was briefly in tight upper stretch, continued on willingly to secure the place position, THE RIDER OF CHIEF MENA CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF BLACK DRESS FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISALLOWED. WHILE THEY DANCE swerved out and bumped RICH IN MERCY leaving the gate, rushed to vie for the lead, dueled along the rail to deep stretch, ceded stubbornly late, hard try. PYRITE HALO stalked while four wide to the half, rallied three wide to duel for the lead at the quarter pole, vied to the sixteenth pole, hung coming to the wire. SO OUTRAGEOUS well placed throughout, bid four to five wide turning for home, loomed upper stretch, flattened out. MISS BERTILA sent hard, led or pressed for the lead to the quarter pole, was all done entering the stretch, used up. RICH IN MERCY was bumped by WHILE THEY DANCE and then moved out to bump BEE A INDY at the start, hustled to stalk running towards the inside, chased under urging mid turn, gave way top of the stretch. DONERAIL DRIVE raced in the second flight, was hard ridden far turn, had no response, gave way and finished weary. BEE A INDY gave poor action shortly after the start, struggled down the backside, was pulled up nearing the half mile marker.
