Footnotes

MIDIANITE stalked REISS'S HALO along the rail, angled between foes mid turn to vie for the lead, went head to head during the stretch run, edged clear late under a stiff drive. REISS'S HALO sent from the gate, set a pressured pace along the rail throughout, dug in under an all out drive form top of the lane, yielded grudgingly in last jumps, second best. LA MAMASITA lacked speed, asked mid turn, came five wide upper stretch, was going well at the wire to gain the show position. CHOCOLETTE rated early, moved towards the inside on the turn, raced between foes from upper stretch, finished in willing manner but was no real threat. BRICK PARTY rushed early, vied thee wide throughout, began to tire mid stretch, had nothing left late. SHOWING PROMISE was slow into stride, angled to the rail entering the stretch, gave mild bid, no real factor. TEACHER PEG lagged far off the pace, outrun to the quarter pole, swung eight wide top of the lane, found best stride too late, finished with interest but was no factor. ECCLESIA hustled along, raced five wide on the bend, chased under a drive, failed to respond, weakened in the lane. ALJARCOB lacked speed, raced towards the rail turning for home, roused to no avail. NEW MEXICO SAND hustled to race up close in the early stages, faded leaving the quarter pole, no factor in the lane.
