Footnotes

CARTER'S PRIDE was never far off the pace racing a little off the rail down the backside, bid three wide to engage for the lead mid turn, edged clear at the quarter pole, turned away a threatening VEGGIE SOUP at the eighth pole, increased margin late under steady handling. VEGGIE SOUP made a slight bobble at the break but quickly recovered, settled in the second flight, made a bold four wide move at the quarter pole, vied with the winner entering the stretch, battled to mid stretch, was turned away and proved a willing second best. SHORE MANOR broke alertly taking the lead, headed mid turn, battled to top of the lane, tired mid stretch but held third place in a good effort. NO BUT CLOSE unhurried early traveling in the second flight, bid turning for home, chased in the lane and leveled off mid stretch needing more. S S PATRIOT raced evenly at mid track, came five wide into the lane, failed to threaten. STREET MUSIC trailed down the backside racing wide, mildly improved position but failed to factor. SILENT HONOR tracked the pace running off the rail, urged mid turn, failed to respond and weakened in upper stretch. PRACTICAL JOKER was a step slow leaving the gate, quickly rushed up along the rail, reached the leaders going into the far turn, vied to the quarter pole, gave way and faded from upper stretch. GOLDEN CAPERS showed brief speed, retreated from mid turn, stopped in upper stretch finishing well beaten.
