HAMPSHIRE DANCER pressured the pace through the turn, shook clear in mid stretch winning under a drive. PLAY THE GAME pressured the pace chasing to upper stretch, extended up for place. MAVATA a step slow early rallied in upper stretch bidding gamely late. LADY VOLDEMORT fog, tracked evenly early then weakened in mid stretch. STORMY HEAT pressured the pace through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. DURANT'S VILLAGE chased early then tired to stretch. SI F SI SI played no factor. MY SISTER CONNIE was always outrun. EUPHRASIA showed early then folded to lane. DENSE FOG PREVENTED A THREE EIGHTHS CALL.
