DARK ENCHANTRESS stalked down the backside, moved off the rail mid turn, bid two wide near the quarter pole, drove clear upper stretch, held safe under steady encouragement. MING WIN stalked to mid turn, launched rally coming three wide upper stretch, closed willingly gaining second place late. LIPGLOSSANDGLITTER sent hard from the gate, cleared and angled to the rail setting the pace, headed by the winner at the quarter pole, ceded control upper stretch, weakened late being outfinished for second place. ALISSA WHO was bothered by GOLDIE ON THE RUN leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, made a bold run entering the stretch, drifted over to the rail mid stretch, narrowed the gap late in a game effort. CLARKSBURG EXPRESS lagged and trailed to top of the lane, found stride mid stretch, finished strongly but never threatened. GOLDIE ON THE RUN veered out sharply bumping ALISSA WHO at the start, moved over to the rail shortly thereafter, gave chase under urging from mid turn, lacked response besting rest. MISS PUDDIN tracked early on traveling three wide, began to fade entering the stretch, no late factor. GABRIELS LANDING lacked speed and saved ground throughout, showed little.
