MARIA'S MOON well rated loomed abreast rivals upper stretch, angled out from the three path toward mid track surging up late under left hand urging. CHILE TEQUILA sent clear set a modest pace holding a working margin to upper stretch, digging in from the two path would be grabbed from the outside in the last strides. SHINE OLA stalked the pace threatening through the far turn into upper stretch, extended between horses late was out gamed to the wire. J'ESPERE raced evenly throughout outbidding the others from mid track down the stretch. INDIABONITA saved ground moving closer on the backside, gave way along the inside on the far turn. DEBERE was never involved racing seven wide through the stretch. AMERICAN BREW failed to respond. BRIGHTIA RUBY hustled out chased for a half then folded up on the far turn.
