Footnotes

PRINCESS JANELLE hustled from the start, dueled inside of RIVER BLADES to the quarter pole, shook that rival off top of the lane, moved out to the two path from upper stretch, increased margin under strong handling to the wire. TAPITFORPAR stalked a contested pace to mid turn, moved off the rail launching rally at the quarter pole, swung four wide chasing the winner top of the stretch, failed to threaten while proving second best. DUSTY LILY sent early, matched strides with the winner to the quarter pole, could not keep pace from top of the stretch, dug in late preserving the show position. TOSCA'S KISS rated early, advanced mid turn and split foes at the quarter pole, was under a stiff drive from upper stretch, needed more late. RIVER BLADES tracked down the backside running three wide, moved out four wide top of the lane giving chase, failed to respond besting rest. SARAH DOUGLAS settled in mid pack along the rail, roused to no avail, no threat. LOLA'S RIDGE lacked speed and traveled mid track throughout, showed little, no factor. SAVILLE HOTEL was always outrun, raced wide down the backside and was eased across the finish line.
