Footnotes

UNBRIDLED WISDOM went to the front immediately, was pressured by BRADY MEISTER for the first three furlongs, was then engaged by LETAPROHAVEAGO nearing the first half mile marker, matched strides with that rival to the far turn, drew off mid turn, held a clear lead with a furlong to go but began to shorten stride a sixteenth out, finished fully extended to just hold on. SOME KINDA TROUBLE unhurried early racing well off the pace, gained momentum with three furlongs to go, came four wide entering the stretch, closed in rapidly approaching the finish line, just missed in a hard effort. OLYMPIST unhurried, racing mid track throughout, launched rally gaining three wide from mid turn, chased the winner from upper stretch, loomed late but was outfinished in last jumps and settled for third best. LETAPROHAVEAGO moved up to join the winner after a half mile, went head to head for the next half mile, began to drop off turning for home, remained under urging in the lane but needed more late. CRITICAL ACCLAIM settled in good tracking position along the rail, angled three wide coming to the quarter pole, gave chase into the stretch, flattened out mid stretch. BRADY MIESTER flashed brief foot to duel with the winner, started to fade after five furlongs, chased leaving the far turn, failed to factor. EL BOMBA gave way after a half mile, trailed thereafter finishing well beaten.
