**Footnotes**

SPANISH SALSA away alertly pressed to lead on the turn, widened in upper stretch holding firm in the three path. SHERI'S GOLD off slowly came six wide upper stretch, closed belatedly for place. MAGGIE'S JEWEL a step slow through the turn, rallied at mid track in deep stretch. LOGAN'S BREW chased through the turn turn, finished evenly four wide. EXECUTIVELY lunged brushing the gate at the break, was rushed in pursuit, tired inside down the lane. WATER THE INFIELD slow early played no factor finishing along the inside. KEEP DA CHANGE outrun early raced eight wide through the stretch. PHOEBE'S SONG retreated along the inside. TAJAREB pressed the pace through the turn then wilted upper stretch. BRIDLE BOUQUET lost ground, was steadied to wire.
