WHY HE'S ENOUGH stalked FOUR AND FIVE RED down the backstretch, drew even leaving the quarter pole, drove clear mid stretch and widened to the wire finishing in hand. FOUR AND FIVE RED broke sharply and quickly opened up on the field, angled to the rail setting the pace, headed by the winner turning for home, was no match from the furlong marker, faltered late and just held second place fully extended. MR FLINCHY was unruly pre-start, settled in the second flight, advanced mid turn, swung to the four path top of the lane, surged under left handed stick to narrowly second place in a willing effort. JUNIORS TRIBUTE tracked the pace traveling in the three path, bid in tandem upper stretch, was outgamed coming to the wire vying for a minor award. DEVIL'S MISTAKE raced evenly in mid pack, bid between foes mid stretch, leveled off late needing more. ROYAL CHAPEL reared at the break, rushed between foes down the backside, angled towards the inside chasing the leaders mid turn, began to tire upper stretch, no late factor. CRUZINGINTHESTORM lacked speed running mid track, roused mid turn, failed to respond, offered little. JAY JAY DYNAMITE was always outrun, never involved. DATE A SAINT was quickly outrun, dull effort.
