Footnotes

CANFIELD lagged to the half, advanced mid turn racing four wide, closed relentlessly in deep stretch to arrive in time for a hard earned victory. SUNSHINE BO set a rated pace traveling in the two path, held a clear lead with a furlong to go, was run down in last jumps missing in a hard effort. HARLAN RUSH unhurried for six furlongs, gained momentum at the quarter pole, closed willingly getting up late for the show position. WAIKIKI tracked the pace racing off the rail, bid mid turn and loomed off of the runner up at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move flattening out inside the eighth pole. VALID RIDE (ARG) raced evenly traveling towards the inside, lacked needed surge despite being hard ridden. ELDOKTORI stalked to the far turn, began to fade coming to the quarter pole, used up. SKIP CODE raced evenly in mid pack, gave way entering the stretch finishing well beaten. PALO DURO CANYON stalked to the half, retreated mid turn, stopped in the drive.
