NAFASS broke alertly, was taken in hand and moved out to the three path, was headed by FACE THE FIRE from his inside at the half, sat patient to mid turn, was asked for more and quickly accelerated to leave the field behind, widened easily being ridden out to the finish. WARDUTY rated early, saved ground down the backside, angled between foes entering the stretch, dueled for the place position, was no threat to the winner. FACE THE FIRE rushed along the rail to vie at the half, proved no match leaving the quarter pole, gave way inside the eighth pole. DIVINE CASTLE lacked speed, saved ground, improved placing in the lane but was no factor. SNEAK A COLD TREAT hustled to chase running four wide to the half, had no response when asked for more, no threat. REFORM SCHOOL raced in the second flight, swung eight wide top of the lane under a drive, varied little. PLANET OF JOY raced up close while three to four wide, loomed under urging to mid turn, gave way in the lane. BOLD STORM RISING raced wide towards the rear, dropped far off the pace mid turn, dull effort. A FORCE OF ONE was off a step slow, dropped far behind mid turn, was eased to the wire.
