Footnotes

BANK OF DAD well rated gave a prompted move on the far turn cutting the corner to upper stretch, angled off the rail blowing past a weary GALLARDO to win going away. FURKA PASS stalked the pace edging closer to threaten on the far turn, extended in the three path down the stretch would edge up late to salvage place. GUARDIANOFTHENORTH unhurried early was circled out to mid track in upper stretch responding willingly the final eighth. GALLARDO made the early lead posting moderate splits while clinging to a slim margin through the far turn, cleared briefly at the head the stretch then was collared along the rail by BANK OF DAD giving way abruptly soon after. ADMIRAL'S ARCH prompted the pace pressuring GALLARDO through the far turn, would waver in upper stretch retreating there. S. S. LIQUIDATOR was never involved. BOLD COMMAND raced evenly four wide then flattened out on the far turn.
