JAY'S SUAVE broke sharply setting the pace hustling the lead through the turn, digging in from the two path down the stretch held to late pressure. JAYGAR DANCER laid close up looming abreast JAYS SUAVE to upper stretch, bore down on winner nearing the wire only to be denied. THREEWISEMEN saved ground circling out to upper stretch, fired six wide vying willingly on the outside. CRIMSON PRINCE slow early saved ground to upper stretch, improved a bit at rail needing more. GOLDEN MAN dropped off on the turn then moved evenly down the stretch. LAKE LUCERNE trailed through the turn, raced three wide through the stretch. SIR HILLARY was never involved finishing up at mid track. JET FLAG faded wide in upper stretch. COPE WITH BILL racing inside was always outrun. DRAW PLAY went evenly through the turn then gave way wide to upper stretch.
