NO FEAR HEAR hustled out was rushed clear on pace carrying a solid lead to upper stretch, digging in from the three path had enough of a cushion to last. SIX MILLER'S tracked the pace racing evenly through the turn, bid mid track down the stretch getting to the winner before running out of ground. LAGOON slow early saved ground to upper stretch finishing well along the rail. SPURIOUS steadied off VISION IMPOSSIBLE early staying back through the turn, swung seven wide in upper stretch gained late. ONE BLUE SKY chased a loose NO FEAR HEAR through the turn to upper stretch, extending in the four path came up short late. LIL GREAT TOUCH slow early was swung out eight wide in upper stretch. VISION IMPOSSIBLE lugged in herding DURAND PARK after the break, would play no factor. SOUTHERN SEBRING was always outrun. DURAND PARK was herded by MISSION IMPOSSIBLE steadying in the early going, rushed to regroup into the turn then leveled off along the inside in upper stretch. THUNDER'S GIFT was always outrun. A stewards inquiry into an incident after the start resulted in no change.
