KAIN'S VOW hustled outside wrested the lead on the turn drawing out to upper stretch, in charge late was kept to task in the four path. THREE COOKIES hopped leaving the gate, trailed early angling out on the turn, came seven wide in upper stretch surging up late to salvage place. FANTASTIC LISA pressured early then chased on the turn, extending at mid track off a loose leader down the lane would hang late. KITTY'S DREAM slow early swung out to upper stretch bidding evenly late six wide. HELLO PRECIOUS hustled out pressured the pace through the turn then wavered in upper stretch giving way along the inside. SWEETASNAILS was always a step slow. SEVEN TIGERS gave way on the turn. CONNIE'S JUNE MOON had brief speed then folded abruptly on the turn.
