Footnotes

POORTOWN RULER made a slight bobble at the break, quickly recovered and moved up to press the pace, gained control traveling three wide mid turn, drew off mid stretch holding firm under steady handling. KASSTOOFAST vied for the lead from the start, raced between foes around the bend, ceded grudgingly to the winner mid stretch, held well saving second place. AKAPESCHE showed good speed dueling for the lead in a three way battle, vied to mid turn, dropped off some leaving the quarter pole, came again in deep stretch to gain the show position in willing effort. AMAZING BUBBA well placed going down the backstretch tracking a trio of duelers, angled mounting rally entering the stretch, loomed off of top pair in upper stretch, lacked needed surge. R H CENTENARIO settled along the rail racing mid pack, angled out at the quarter pole under a drive, came four wide upper stretch, flattened out late never menacing. JACARDI lacked speed, angled towards the rail leaving the quarter pole, mildly improved placing but never factored. RED ON THE HEAD was always outrun, raced five wide into the lane, offered little. SUDDSY SUNDAY raced evenly in mid pack, failed to respond when roused and weakened from upper stretch. FALSE HOPE flashed brief foot, gave chase to mid turn, gave way entering the stretch finishing spent. ROCK THE HARBOR bobbed and slightly swerved leaving the gate losing the rider.
