Footnotes

CAN'T BE PETE raced up close stalking the pace running four wide down the backstretch, bid mid turn and vied in a three way battle, edged cleared remaining off the rail in upper stretch, held sway under a stiff drive to the finish. BORN TO TANGO settled in the second flight, rallied near the quarter pole, angled towards the inside mid stretch, surged late securing the place position. LIVEINTHEPRESENT was well placed going down the backside, rallied five wide entering the stretch, almost drew even with CAN'T BE PETE in mid stretch, hung coming to the wire despite being hard ridden. HE'S A BIG DADDY lagged far off the pace, gained momentum mid turn, came four wide top of the lane, split rivals in the drive and finished strongly finding best stride too late. YOUR HOUR'S UP tracked the pace traveling mid track going to the half, asked on the bend, moved to a menacing position in upper stretch, leveled off needing more. BANE raced evenly in the second flight, failed to respond when asked for more, no threat. LIVELY EXIT broke inward and was briefly steadied leaving the gate, unhurried racing towards the rear, failed to threaten. CHASING THE FOX hustled off and set a pressured pace racing a little off the rail, headed mid turn, dug in and fought hard to mid stretch, gave way late. TURTLE SOUP was always outrun, never involved. SUNSHINE BEAR raced along the rail stalking the leader down the backside, moved along the rail mid turn to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, started to give way in upper stretch, faded to the finish.
