Footnotes

GOING BROKE BABY was forwardly placed tracking a contested pace, launched rally leaving the quarter pole, came three wide entering the stretch, collared MARTINI JANE mid stretch, edged away and held safe under steady encouragement. TURN TO RAIN lacked speed in the early going running towards the inside, angled out mid stretch under a drive, surged strongly nearing the finish line. MARTINI JANE rushed from the start, pressed for the lead going around the turn, took control entering the stretch and angled to the rail, proved no match with a sixteenth to go and was out nodded losing second place. QUEENSTEEN pressed for the lead shortly after the start, drove clear mid turn and was soon headed by MARTINI JANE at the quarter pole, ceded the lead entering the stretch and faded inside the eighth pole. WE GAIJIN was hard urged from the gate, took a slight early lead going into the far turn, headed by mid turn and lost the lead at the quarter pole, chased from upper stretch and weakened in the drive. INDIAN PEAKS was a step slow into stride, raced mid track throughout, swung five wide into the lane, failed to threaten. LEES CAP lacked speed and dropped off to trail by mid turn, showed little
