QUICK ARGUMENT pressured the pace from between horses through the turn, dueling abreast DEVILSFROSTREPORT down the lane would extend up at the wire. DEVILSFROSTREPORT led early then dueled inside of rivals through the turn, went step for step with QUICK ARGUMENT down the stretch battling inside that one to the end. DUCHESS OF SPAIN pressed three deep through the turn ceding a clear lead to rivals in upper stretch, continued on evenly from the eighth pole holding position in the four path. PERFECT CHIMING raced evenly throughout finishing up near mid track. MI MARGARITA slow early saved ground to upper stretch showing some late interest in the two path. GIACOMAE MOUNTAIN ducked in at the break, showed early speed then dropped off on the turn, raced six wide down the stretch. AUTIE in tight at the break would play no factor. CASEYS CACTUS flashed early speed then faded along the rail on the turn. CHOCOLATE AFFAIR chased early then faded from the five sixteenths pole. MEGA SENNA showed little.
