Footnotes

IT'S GOTTA BE US broke alertly pressuring the pace matching strides with B L'S SAND SHARK through the turn, dueling abreast rival down the lane would edge clear at the end. B L'S SAND SHARK sent inside pressed the pace through the turn, dueling inside of IT'S GOTTA BE US in upper stretch was in a bit close ceding while angling out late. DUTY ROSTER slow early trailed on the turn, responded in upper stretch firing in the four path closing in late. SMOOTH TRANSITION off slowly was outrun through the turn, taken seven then eight wide down the lane would improve a bit. MORENO STAR chased early inside, began to weaken on the turn, angled from the three to the seven path in mid stretch finishing evenly. EXOTIC WILDCAT played no factor moving eight and nine wide down the lane. SOUTHERN TWISTER weakened on the turn dropping from contention. GRAND ROW was never involved. KEEN CASE chased early wearing down on the turn fading into upper stretch. NAMATH chased the early pace, wilting to upper stretch was pulled up, walking off. An objection from the rider of B L'S SAND SHARK against the rider of IT'S GOTTA BE US for interference during the stretch run was disallowed by the stewards.
