TAKE IT OUT broke alertly and angled to the rail, dueled in a three way battle to mid turn, drew off top of the lane, won comfortably being ridden out. SOFIA AND MIA settled in mid pack racing off the rail, angled five wide upper stretch, closed fast proving second best. KISS THIS LOVE lacked speed running in the second flight, swung out seven wide top of the stretch, received left handed stick in the lane and responded belatedly picking up third place. SWEET RUBY KATE raced up close going down the backside, bid three wide mid turn and vied for the lead at the quarter pole, could not keep pace from mid stretch, flattened out missing a minor award. HERES HOPE dueled to mid turn running between foes to the three eighths pole, gave way in upper stretch. PRIVATE PARADE lacked speed running towards the rear, raced six wide from upper stretch, improved placing but never menaced. WHY WHY WONDER was urged leaving the gate, lacked needed bid and weakened in the drive. ANNIE'S IN CHARGE was bumped by SHEZACLASSYGURL leaving the gate, trailed running along the rail, offered little. SHEZACLASSYGURL bobbed and swerved in bumping ANNIE'S IN CHARGE, traveled in the second flight, offered little. LYLA DAWN flashed brief foot running in the two path, was all done giving way turning for home.
