SO SO broke sharply pressing past HIGH TAILIN IT to clear on the turn, opened up a commanding lead in upper stretch breezing home under a hand ride. TENKILLER LAKE raced evenly off a brisk pace through the turn, gave an inside move in upper stretch out dueling TWO CATS under full extension to salvage place. TWO CATS evenly off the pace rallied into upper stretch, angling inside responded in drive giving all near the rail late. MOON IS A STAR away slowly was outrun through the turn, responded four wide through the lane finishing well. CAP IT slow early gave a mild move to upper stretch, gave even action in drive. SNEAK A COLD TREAT slow early came evenly to upper stretch, proved no late menace. MY FRIEND DEKE dropped back on the turn. HIGH TAILIN IT broke alert pressing then chasing SO SO through the turn, would fold weary in upper stretch. BEAR GLADIATOR away slowly would struggle.
