SPECIAL EVENT was hustled out, chased then pressed abreast SPECIAL EVENT to lane, edged up to lead late then dug in. AVER tracked evenly, fired into upper stretch, was gaining with every stride late. LITE BRIGADE broke sharply, set a pressured pace through the turn, dueled in upper stretch then weakened late. AIM TO VICTORY off slowly was outrun through the turn, found late stride gaining belatedly. SIR ROMEO slow early played no factor. SIR SPEEDATOR chased the pace through the turn then wore down in upper stretch. KISS A COYOTE lost ground proving no factor. DAKOTA FREEWAY bobbled at the break, was always outrun. THUNDER MOUNTAIN gave way on the turn.
