Footnotes

WHAT THE HAIL well placed early, stalked duel along the rail, moved up mid turn to vie for the lead, dueled inside of JUST A PATTON from the quarter pole to the sixteenth pole, started to edge away under strong handling nearing the wire. JUST A PATTON hustled and dueled early on racing between rivals, fought hard to the sixteenth pole, weakened from there, proved second best. GOLD CASE DIAMOND rushed after the start to vie for command racing four wide, pressed hard to top of the lane, tired mid stretch, bested rest. JESSIEBDANCING broke alertly, dueled racing between rivals soon after the start, started to tire when entering the stretch, no threat in the stretch run. CROWNED IN ROSES lacked speed, saved ground throughout, did manage to give a belated run but was no factor. CLEVER SIS was slow early, raced towards the inside, gave a mild gain but was no factor. GAMBETTO had no speed, raced off the rail, asked but never responded. EAGLE RUN raced evenly at mid track, roused from mid turn, gave no response and weakened upper stretch. RO BA TE NA rushed soon after the start, raced wide throughout, chased at the quarter pole, gave way mid stretch. MIAMUNDO was always outrun, never involved.
