SWEET JOAN bobbled leaving the gate but quickly recovered, made a steady inside gain down the backside, angled out to the two path mid turn taking aim on KELLY'S LIGHT, collared that rival and dueled entering the stretch, slowly edged away inside the furlong marker under steady encouragement. TRACEY'SLASTTRICK stalked racing off the rail down the backside, set down coming three wide into the lane, chased the winner to the wire but failed to gain late proving second best. KELLY'S LIGHT broke alertly and angled towards the rail, set the pace to the quarter pole, fought gamely to mid stretch with the winner, weakened late holding on to third place. EYE CAN ROAR raced evenly towards the inside, mildly responded in the lane but needed more to menace. MIAMI'S SECRET trailed racing widest racing down the backstretch, found best stride mid stretch, showed belated interest but never factored. JOE'S RISING STAR settled in the second flight racing mid track, put to a drive near the quarter pole, failed to respond never threatening. BELLE OF THE CLASS raced wide being outrun early, offered little. ONEFASTWILDCAT showed good early speed stalking to the mid turn running three wide, began to weaken upper stretch, stopped inside the eighth pole finishing spent.
