BANK OF DAD brushed at the beak tracked the pace laying close through the turn, saved ground to upper stretch surging in the two path out dueling EUROVALENTINO in the final yards. EUROVALENTINO stalked close up through the turn, pressed to even terms at mid track in upper stretch, dueled abreast BANK OF DAD from the eighth pole giving all to no avail. FAST FASHION pressured early then chased through the turn, dropped off the top pair in upper stretch finishing evenly near mid track. WONDER WAY raced mid pack coming four wide in upper stretch proving no menace. SHY LOVER away alertly worked on a short lead through the turn then faded in the three path upper stretch. FASTER THAN FLASH veered in with his head thrashing about at the break, well back after labored home. CITY TRAIN folded up on the turn. M'S WILL was pulled up and vanned off.
