PROUD TEARS away slowly labored through the turn, hit stride near the eighth pole surging through a wide gap in the four path arriving in time. LOVELAND hustled to grab a short lead setting the pace from off the inside, managed to keep a head in front under constant pressure to upper stretch ceding grudgingly in the final yards. SHINY DANCER broke alert chasing close up through the turn, came six wide into upper stretch giving solid late response. SEMICHI sent hard prompting LOVELAND on pace, weakening a bit near the three sixteenths pole was taken wide regrouping somewhat to prove a late factor. VICTORIOUS HALO off slowly angled inside finishing with interest. CHEERFUL COPY hustled out chased then pressed LOVELAND into upper stretch, wore down in drive. HALO'S WILDCAT raced evenly trying to mount an eight wide bid in upper stretch, wavered under a drive. A LITTLE GOLD gave early pursuit dropping off on the turn. TEXAS GOLD DIGGER bucked at the break, couldn't recover giving way to stretch.
